AMENDMENT TO AMENDED AND RESTATED DECLARATION OF COVENANTS, CONDITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS FOR UNIVERSITY PLACE

ARTICLE VI USE RESTRICTIONS AND COVENANTS

6.07 Commercial and Recreational Vehicles. Unless prior approval has been granted by the Board, no commercial vehicle, recreational vehicle, trailer, camper, motor home, panel truck, canoe or boat of any kind shall park, or be parked, or stored at any time on a Lot or upon any roadway or common area depicted on the Plats of the Neighborhood described in Article 2.01 unless such a vehicle is in a garage or is a commercial vehicle in the process of being loaded or unloaded or when a commercial service provider is actively providing a service to a Lot or the common area. The Board may approve special storage arrangements for such vehicles, imposing strict locational, time and other considerations as may determine. A "panel truck" is a van or mini-van which does not have any rear passenger windows. "Commercial vehicle" means a vehicle that is owned or used by a business, corporation, association, partnership, or sole proprietorship, or any other entity conducting business for a commercial purpose, including without limitation, any vehicle displaying a commercial tag, lettering, logo, symbol, or trademark on the vehicle's exterior. The Board may adopt and promulgated additional standards for commercial and recreational vehicles, and may revise or expand such standards from time to time to take cognizance of new forms or variations of commercial and/or recreational vehicles. In the event that there is any dispute as to whether a particular vehicle is a commercial or recreational vehicle, such dispute shall be referred to the Board and the determination rendered by the Board with respect to such dispute shall be final and binding upon all parties thereto.

6.08 Maintenance and Storage of Boats and Vehicles. No maintenance, repair or storage of any boat or vehicle, shall be permitted upon any Lot except with an enclosed garage.

6.10 <u>Vehicles</u>, <u>Parking</u>, and <u>Repairs</u>. No inoperative ears, trucks, or trailers or other type of vehicles of any type will be allowed to remain on any portion of the common areas or any roadway depicted on the <u>Plats</u> of the <u>Neighborhood described in Article 2.01 for any period of time</u> or adjacent to upon any Lot for a period in excess of forty-eight (48) hours; however, this provision shall not apply to such vehicle which is kept within an enclosed garage. No repairs shall be made to any vehicle unless made within an enclosed garage. In addition to those vehicles described in Article 6.07, no other vehicle of any type shall be parked upon any common area or roadway depicted on the <u>Plats</u> of the <u>Neighborhood described</u> in Article 2.01 unless prior approval has been granted by the Board.
