IMPORTANT NEWS - NEW KEY FOB SYSTEM

Our broken and outdated Eclipse key fob system is being replaced. Installation by 3 LOGIC is underway at both the Charlestown and Seven Oaks Pools. Old Fob readers have been removed, therefore for the next several weeks both pools will be open with NO Fob System until we transition to the new system.

Beginning today March 9 at the **Charlestown Pool**, all residents will be able to purchase new Fobs - \$12.00 for two – cash or check to UP HOA. You may purchase an additional 2 Fobs for \$25 each.
