STORM READINESS

Hurricane season is in full swing. Be sure your home and landscaping are storm ready and remove all objects from your yard that could become projectiles if a storm is imminent. Hurricane protection (i.e. shutters, plywood, Kevlar fabric) may be put up when University Place is within the predicted path of a named storm, however they must be taken down within 14 days of the end of the storm. The exception to this rule is clear Lexan shutters which may remain in place for the hurricane season.

The gold numbers on the plaques may be painted black, or the plaque may be replaced with the Oakview Address Plaque which is available for purchase from Frontgate (frontgate.com).
